Keep Safe, Well and Warm has been an initiative championed by Falkirk Adult Protection Committee since 2023. We are delighted to be launching our 2025/26 campaign jointly with Child Protection Committee this year. Each year we have further developed the leaflet highlighting local and national supports to keep safe, well and warm in winter – this year it covers the lifespan.



Stay Warm – emergency numbers for assistance with gas, electricity and water are included alongside highlighting support to access the [Living Well website](#) at our libraries. A broader range of helplines are available on the leaflet back page.

Stay Well – new sections this year include highlighting mental health support for young people, winter vaccinations, Keep Well assessments, The Royal Voluntary Service and Cyrenians.

Stay Safe – new sections this year include reporting child protection concerns and hate crime routes to support and crime reporting. You can watch our recent public protection hate crime webinar [HERE](#)
