The general contact workforce is defined as those who, as part of their job are likely to come into contact with adults including adults at risk and other family members and carers.	The specific contact workforce is defined as those who: carry out direct work with adults, and specifically adults at risk and their families and carers; and / or form more in-depth relationships with them; and / or provide specific services to them.	The intensive contact workforce is defined as those who have specific designated responsibility for adult protection issues as part of their role (e.g. where this is linked to their post, or where they are a Council Officer or Lead Professional); and / or those who will be involved in undertaking adult protection investigations or working with complex cases (e.g. providing particular forms of support relating directly to adult protection).
