Please see below for all core ASP training courses being delivered in 2026.

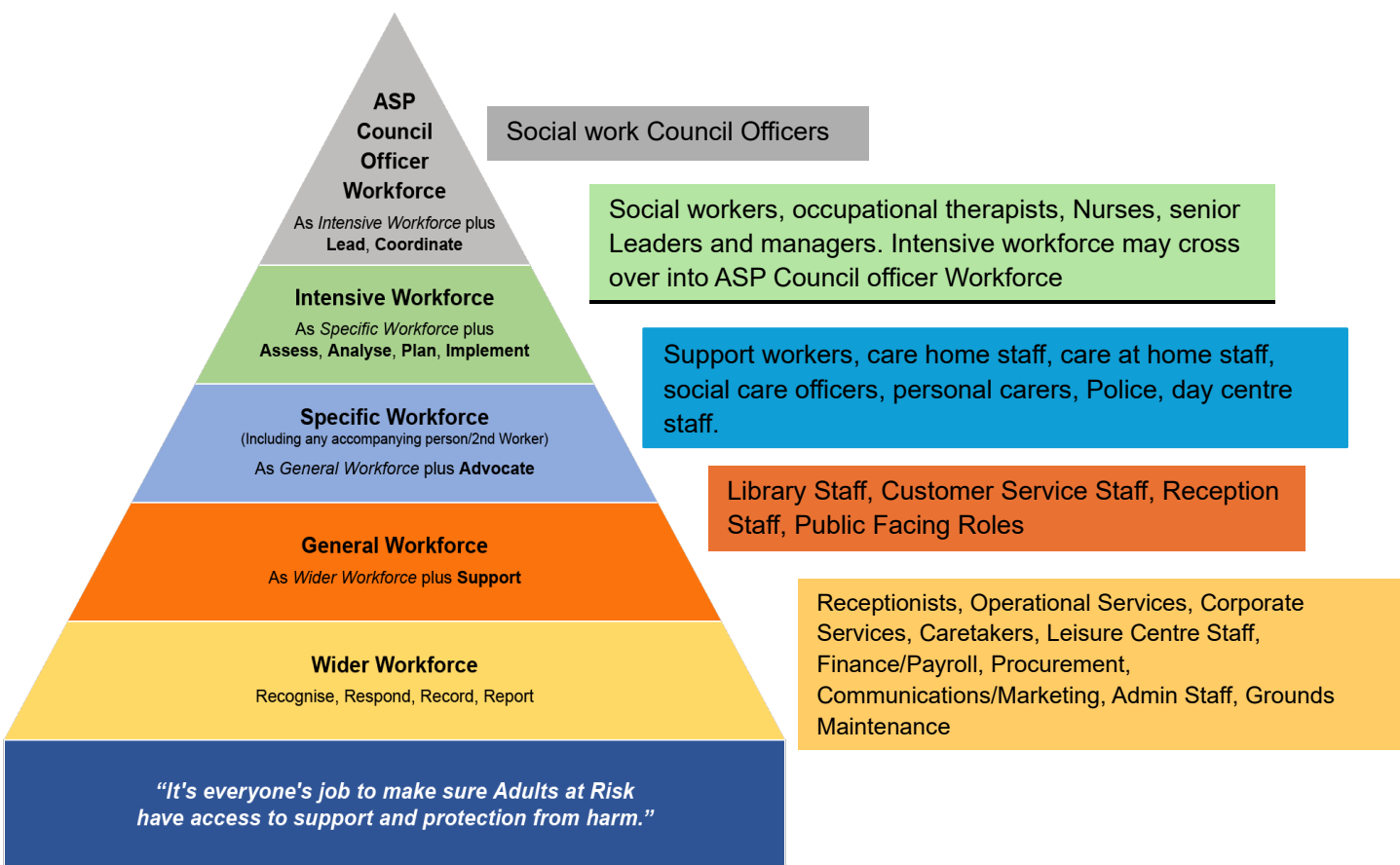

ASP Council Officer Workforce	Council Officers	Lead statutory ASP inquiries and investigations; carry out formal ASP duties; make statutory decisions; apply for Protection Orders; lead multi-agency case conferences and protection planning.
Intensive Workforce	Occupational Therapists, Social Workers, Nurses, senior leaders and managers.	Carry out ASP assessment and analysis; plan and coordinate support; apply advanced ASP knowledge; work directly with adults at risk; provide professional input to ASP inquiries.
Specific Workforce	Support Workers, Care Home Staff, Housing Officers, Police, Day Centre Staff, anyone working closely with vulnerable people.	Recognise wider harm; respond safely; share information lawfully; contribute to early ASP processes; support prevention and wellbeing.
General Workforce	Library Staff, Customer Service Staff, Reception Staff, Public Facing Roles.	Understand they do not investigate or assess; recognise and report concerns; support safeguarding culture.
Wider Workforce	Operational Services, Corporate Services, Caretakers, Leisure Centre Staff, Finance/Payroll, Procurement, Communications/Marketing, Admin Staff, Grounds Maintenance, staff that may be behind the scenes within organisations and are not public facing.	Basic awareness; know what harm is; know how to report concerns internally; understand safeguarding is everyone's responsibility.
