



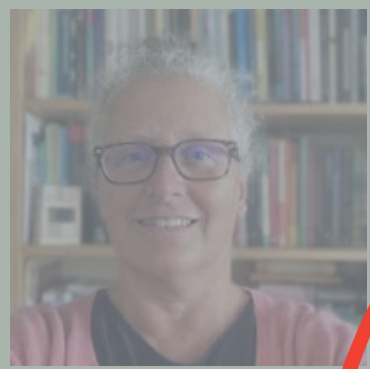
CLPL Series
