INCLUSION SUPPORT AND DEVELOPMENT GROUP

What happens in the Inclusion Support and **Development Group?**

- You will attend six sessions, in a group of around 25 led by an EP and a SLT, focused on developing your skills in successfully including children with additional support needs (ASN).
- You will have the opportunity to discuss issues related to children you are working with, with your peers and other professionals.
- You will get the chance to learn from invited professionals such as OTs, EAL staff, as suits the group's needs.
- You will be expected to try things out between sessions and reflect on your practice.
- You will get a warm welcome and a hot drink!

The group gave me some fantastic insights into inclusive practice and really made me reflect on my own practice.

I am using lots of the information shared at sessions to cascade to the staff team. I feel I have learned lots of new and relevant information to support me in my role.
