The remit of the Early Years Assessment Teams will include the following:

Initial point of contact for Glasgow Education Services, establishing close working partnerships and effective collaborative practice with Community and Specialist Health services;

Facilitating and supporting transition to a suitable Early Years neighbourhood establishment through effective and focussed collaboration with nursery Heads underpinned by robust transition planning;

Close and timely liaison with Educational Psychologists where assessment indicates the potential need for a specialist nursery placement;

Linking with nursery staff, where appropriate, to ensure a smooth and effective transition.

Supporting parents/carers with transition into early years education.

Providing timely support to Early years centres through clear and effective engagement processes agreed between all education professionals involved.

Engagement with, and signposting to, statutory and third sector services where required;

Signposting of additional support services to parents/carers.
