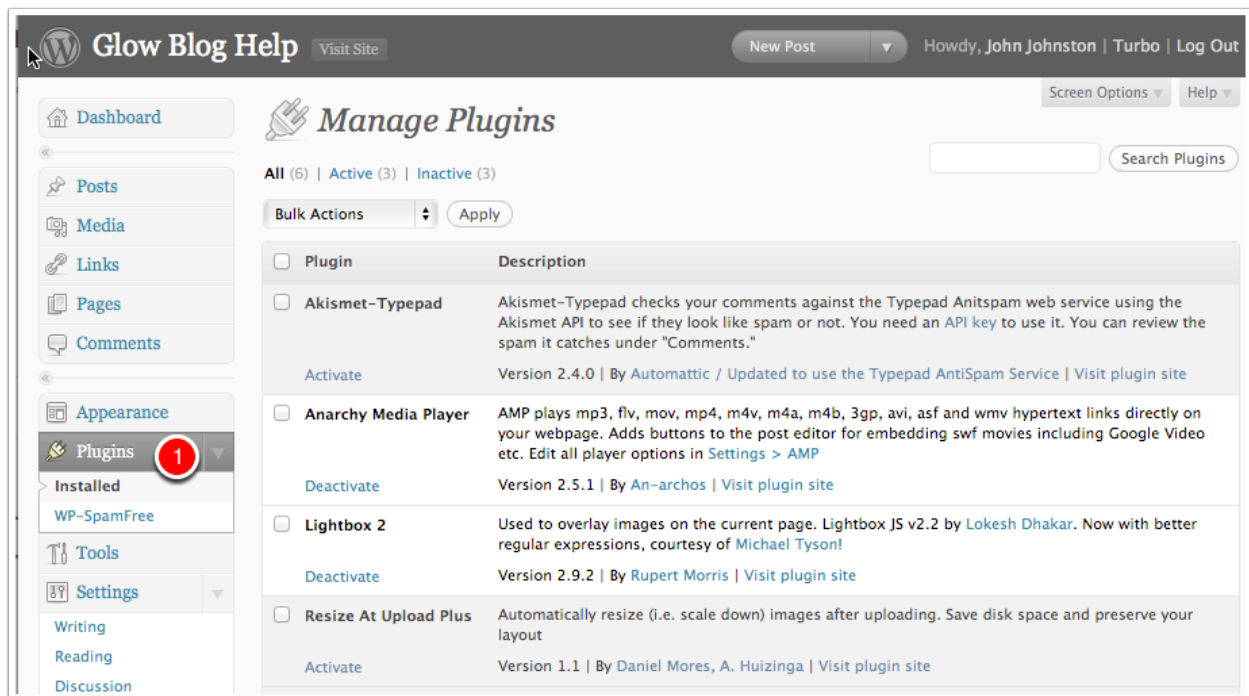


# Plugins

*Plugins are programming scripts that add additional functionality to your blog. These are often features which either enhance already available features or add them to your blog.*

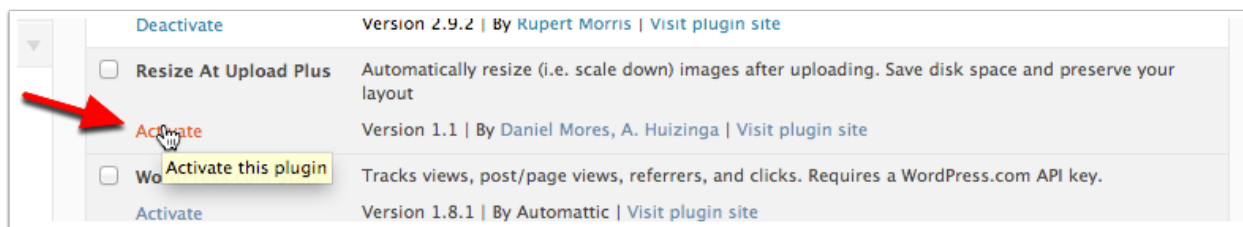
## Manage plugins settings

You can access the manage plugins screen in the dashboard from the navigation menu on the left[1].



## Activating a plugging

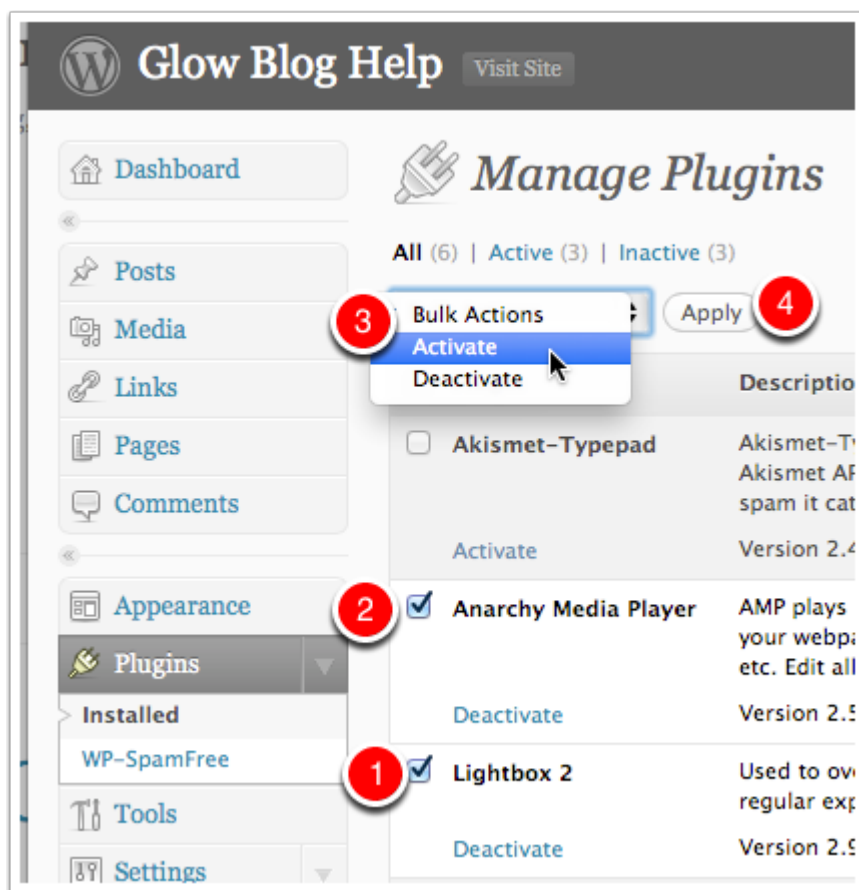
Individual plugins can be activated or deactivated with the Activate and Deactivate links at appear under the plugin name in the list.



## Activating several plugins

You can activate or deactivate more than one plugin at a time by checking the boxes beside their name [1 & 2].

You then choose the Action from the popup at the top of the list [3] (or the one at the bottom) and click Apply [4].



## Plugin Options

After activation the plugin may add a screen to your dashboard for configuration settings. The Screen below shows the Lightbox 2 options and points out the links to the other plugin settings screens.

The screens may be added to the settings section of the dashboard or elsewhere depending on the plugin.
