On the Come Up by Angie Thomas

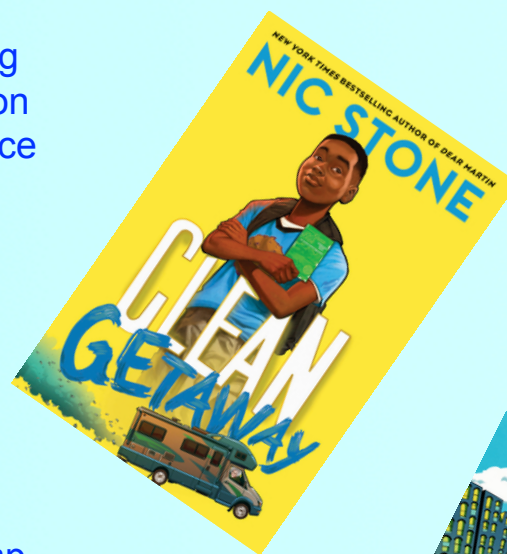
Girl. Boy. Sea. By Chris Vick

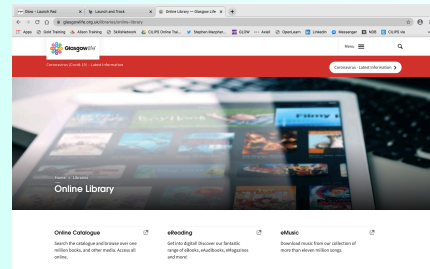

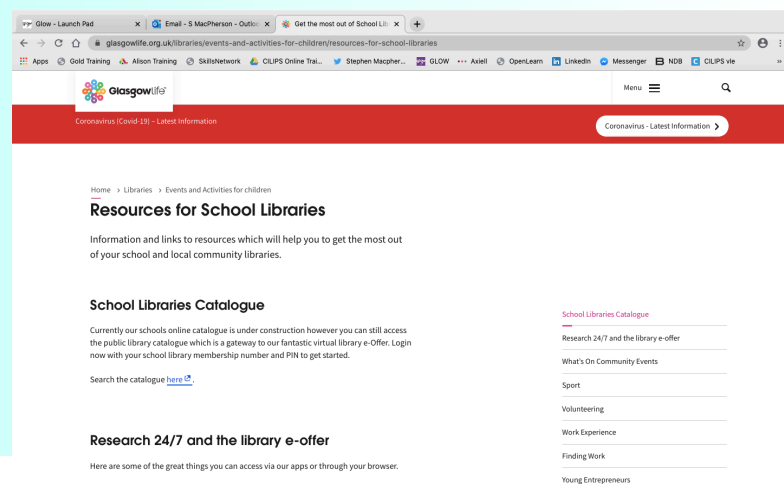
The web address should take you to a webpage similar to this one:
