Our Improvement Plan priorities for 2024- 2025 are:

- 3. To review and refine systems and processes which will improve data collection and the learning and teaching

Planning and Recording progress

We have recently made changes to our planning and recording processes to ensure this can be done while engaging and working alongside the children. Our staff will continue to plan and record children's learning however we will no longer be using the termly learning stories. There are three ways we record and share children's progress and achievements which include. 1. Through Seesaw our online platform, 2. Through observations and other learning which can be found in their special book, 3. Through floor books to gather children's ideas, knowledge and next steps. Staff will continue to engage and meet with parents around their personal learning targets and any changes to your child's health, wellbeing or safety needs.

Fundraising for Christmas

We are hoping to participate in a Christmas fundraiser using "Mychildsart". We have never used this before however have been assured it's a no obligation to buy. We have been issued templates and all children will create their individual art work. This will be sent away and there
