Registration for School

Registration for School for August 2025 will be an online process and will take place during the period Monday 11 November 2024 and Sunday 24 November 2024.

Usually children whose 4th birthday falls in either January or February can apply for a deferred year at nursery. However, due to a motion at parliament any child who won't be 5 when they start School can defer (September through to February). Many parents feel their children benefit from an extra year to help their emotional development. If you would like to have a discussion or to find out more information about deferring, please speak to Alicia or Shirley Anne. Please note, if you are deferring you must still register for School online. All deferrals must be submitted by 20th December 2024.
