Here is a little reminder of how to comment and post on your child's Learning Journal:


Step One:

When you are on the daily posts, press the blue button under your child's name.



Step Two:

- This page will come up next. Within the box section, this is where you can comment on what your child has been doing.
- Pressing the green button (upload photos/videos) will allow you to add photos.
- Once complete press publish and then the green finish button.
