OVERVIEW

We use a rotation model. We have a double period block for 6 weeks with practical size sets of S2s. Each week they get an MVP presentation from different groups of senior pupils. In other rotations the S2s are experiencing blocks of Anti-Racism Education, Forest Schools, First Aid and a sustainable communities design challenge. This is all part of the school's Global Goals programme.

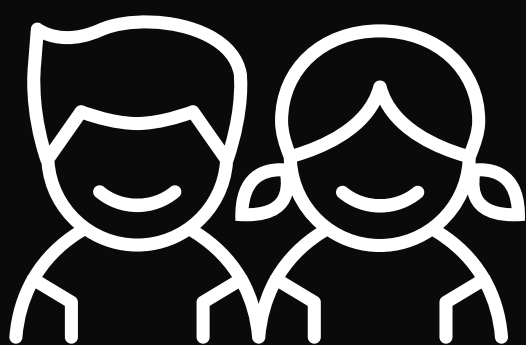
BENEFITS

- S2 pupils experience presentations from a range of seniors - who all have their different styles to bring to the format.
- This is a 6 week block - so the S2 pupils get used to the format.
- Having a double period means that there is plenty of time for the weekly activity, without the need to rush through sections.

CHALLENGES

- We have only run this for one block so far - there may be more challenges ahead, but so far the main challenge is staffing, and ensuring that the right people are available to staff the sessions.
