OVERVIEW

Mentors receive training in June and deliver Core Session 1 as part of the P7 Transition week. Sessions are then delivered throughout the year in PSE lessons, with mentors excused from classes to deliver. The choice of MVP session delivered to each year group is done through discussion with Guidance & SLT as to what issues are most pertinent.

New mentors are offered the chance to speak with experienced mentors. We also make sure that there is an experienced mentor with each group for delivery.

The mentors deliver a session to teaching staff each year. This has been really informative for staff and the mentors have thoroughly enjoyed turning the tables on their teachers!

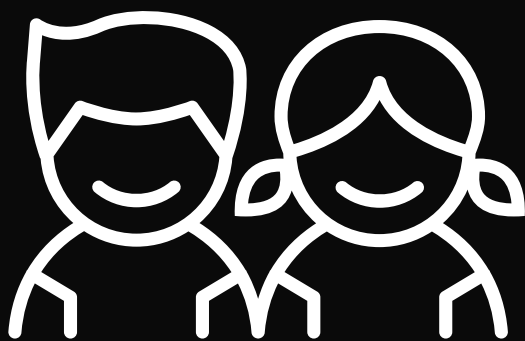
BENEFITS
