Numeracy

We will be continuing with our Number Talks where we share our thinking strategies with the class. In the first term, we will also be focussing place value to 100 and addition. Miss Fraser will also start measurement. It will be a busy time in P2H!

The children will be given reading, common and phoneme words to practice along with some maths activities on Sumdog. Homework will continue to be uploaded by teachers onto teams. However, we would ask the children to complete the homework in their jotter and return this to school on Friday.
