Interdisciplinary Learning

We are currently all reading the same novel to begin the year. This gives the children and I time to look at reading targets together. In writing, the children have already started with narrative. They will also get a chance to complete letter writing through IDL. In addition to this, the class will learn Gaelic and have already learned new vocabulary. They are also keen to use British Sign Language (BSL) and they have learned the alphabet which they can use to practise their spelling.

Numeracy

I have already said to the children that learning their tables and being confident with their number bonds is crucial if they want to feel ready and confident in other areas of maths. In class we will cover number and place value, factors/multiples, and measure.
