# **Interdisciplinary Learning**

We will begin to read our new books each week and they will be set tasks to complete to ensure they understand what the author is saying. Please encourage your children to keep reading at home.

We will also be working on our handwriting and grammar throughout the year, and this will be encouraged throughout all curricular areas. Our writing genres for this term will be **Instructional, Non-Fiction and Persuasive**. We will be focussing on adjectives, verbs, and nouns. The children have already begun to work on their spelling, they will be completing a range of activities to help with tricky words. The children will be given weekly spelling tests.

### **Numeracy**

Our focus this term will be Number and Number processes. The children will be focussing on their Outer Maths with Miss Tsang on a Monday and Tuesday. The focus for this term is 2D Shapes & 3D objects. Our Number Talks and Mental Agility will be a part of our everyday learning.

#### <u>Homework</u>
