Interdisciplinary Learning

Our class IDL topic will be Endangered Animals. We will be learning about different type of species becoming endangered or extinct. We will be discussing about current issues and issues happening in other countries.

Health and Wellbeing

The children will continue to learn about the SHANARRI indicators focusing on Safe and Included. We will also be continuing to look at Emotion Works.

<u>P.E</u>

<u>ICT</u>

Literacy

The class will continue to focus on spelling strategies and continue to focus on the North Lanarkshire Active Literacy Program for reading with a range of nonfiction and fiction books. The children will continue to build on their understanding of books and complete reading strategy questions.

In writing, the children have developed an awareness on information and explanation writing. During Term 3, the children will focus on persuasive, explanation and narrative writing. The children will continue to be taught handwriting, spelling and grammar daily.

Numeracy

Over Term 3, we will be continuing to develop our mental math strategies through a range of Number Talks. The children will be learning about data handling and to describe and understand how data can be presented in different ways. We will also be looking at measurement and how to give an appropriate estimate. The children will continue use their problem-solving skills and immerse in mental agility.

<u>Homework</u>

Homework will be given out every Monday and to be completed before Friday. The children will be given a reading book, phoneme words and common words to practise at home along with some maths activities. Children will have access to SumDog and Educandy. Homework will continue to be uploaded to teams. Children would complete homework in their jotter and return their homework folder to school on Fridays.
