Welcome to Primary P4C

I hope everyone had a lovely Easter break. How quickly the year has gone, and we are now into our last term of the year!

Interdisciplinary Learning

Our Interdisciplinary learning this term will be 'Spring/Planting' and 'The Euros'. We will be learning about the host country of Germany and comparing it to Scotland.

Health and Wellbeing

Our school will be focussing on the SHANARRI indicators and continuing to explore our feelings and behaviours using Emotion Works.

Literacy

Our reading activities will focus on the North Lanarkshire Active literacy program for spelling, phonics and reading. The children will develop their common word and phoneme knowledge and understanding and use of the six reading strategies. In writing, our genres will be recounts and explanations. The children will be taught grammar, spelling, and handwriting on a weekly basis.

Numeracy

We will continue to work on our Number Talks where we share our thinking strategies with the class and mental maths. We will be working on data handling and ideas of chance and uncertainty. Also, we will be investigating angles and transformation, expressions and equations and revising number and the number processes. So, we will be very busy in maths and numeracy this term!

P.E

Our P.E. days will be Tuesday (outdoors, hopefully) and Wednesday (indoors). Please ensure the children have appropriate clothing and footwear for both. Children can come to school dressed in their PE kits as they will not be getting changed in school. The focus for PE this term will be athletics, striking and fielding, golf, and badminton.

ICT

We will be developing our ICT skills, using the ipads and laptops for Interdisciplinary learning and Sumdog in maths.

The children will be given reading, common and phoneme words to practice along with some maths activities. Homework will continue to be uploaded by teachers onto teams. However, we would ask the children to complete the homework in their jotter and return this to school on Friday.
