Interdisciplinary Learning

<u>ICT</u>

The pupils will continuously be working with the class iPads for maths and literacy using a variety of apps such as SumDog, Topmarks, Studyladder and Educandy to support their leaning.

<u>Literacy</u>

This term the class will begin with group novels which are to be a challenge for each group. The novels are as follows: The Borrowers, The Butterfly Lion, Fantastic Mr Fox and ...During this time the pupils will apply the 6 reading strategies which they should be increasingly familiar with allowing them to begin working more independently on these. The pupils will continue with their respective

spelling programs designed to challenge each pupil

appropriately.

Numeracy

This term the pupils will begin revising and increasing their understanding of time. This will include 12- and 24-hour conversions as well as understanding how to read bus/train timetables focusing on durations and applying their problem-solving skills. The pupils will then move onto to Money and use

their previous knowledge of decimals and percentages to solve a variety of money problems.

Toward the end of term the pupils will begin their Angles and Bearings topic learning how to calculate and use a variety of angles as well as use their knowledge of bearings to work out routes and destinations on maps and with a compass.

Homework

Homework will be assigned on teams online and will consist, this term, of chapters to read from group novels as well as spelling words practise and maths revision sheets relating to the work we will be covering in class.
