## **Numeracy**

We will be continuing to develop our mental math strategies through a range of number talks. Children will be continuing to learn more about mental and written adding, subtracting, multiplication and division methods, as well as being encouraged to estimate an answer before calculating it. This term there will be a focus on algebra, 2D and 3D shapes and angles.
