Literacy

Our reading activities will be planned with the North Lanarkshire Active Literacy Programme. Numeracy

In maths this term we will be learning about place value, shape, time & money. We will do Number Talks on a daily basis where children are encouraged to share their learning strategies with their friends.

Homework

Children will be given reading, common and phoneme words home in addition to maths work including Sumdog & Top Marks. All log ins are available for children in their homework jotters. Homework will be uploaded weekly onto teams. We do ask that children complete the homework in their jotters and return this to school on Friday, along with all reading books.
