Interdisciplinary Learning

Our Interdisciplinary learning this term will be Paddington Bear followed by Space. We look forward to working with P3D during our Space topic. We are excited to share our learning with you at home. We will also be learning about energy & electricity in Science which we are all excited about! Children have already identified different types of electricity around us.

Health and Wellbeing

We will be focussing on the SHANARRI indicators and using Emotion Works.

Literacy

Our reading activities will be planned with the North Lanarkshire Active Literacy Programme. Children will develop their common word and phoneme knowledge and understanding and use of our reading strategies. In writing, our genres will be linked to our IDL & Science Topics. The children will be taught grammar, spelling, reading and handwriting each week.

Numeracy

In maths this term we will be learning about data handling, measure & we will revisit our time topic from Term 1. We will do Number Talks on a daily basis where children are encouraged to share their learning strategies with their friends. Children are currently looking at the 2 and 4x tables. With some looking at the 3x table.

P.E

Our P.E. days are Monday(outdoors) and Friday (indoors). Children can come to school dressed in their PE kits. The focus for PE this term will be ball skills and team building games. We are excited to do some joint indoor P.E with our friends in P3D.

ICT

We will be using iPads and laptops to enhance our learning experiences. We have been enjoying STEAM and learning to code & use the Spheros. We are excited to share our learning with P4C!
