Literacy

I am very excited to share with you what your child will be learning in Literacy this year. We will be following North Lanarkshire's Active Literacy programme which consists of learning 2 sounds and 3 common words per week. Our aim is to build strong foundations in reading, writing, speaking, and listening. Which will be taught through a variety of structured and play based learning experiences to develop their knowledge and understanding. This will be facilitated through partner, small group and whole class participation.

We look forward to an exciting year in literacy, where children will learn, play and grow as confident readers and story tellers.

Numeracy

In primary 1H we will be exploring maths through a fun play-based approach. The children will be learning by using real objects, games, songs and practical experiences that make maths meaningful and enjoyable. The children will cover a wide variety of learning in maths from number processes, ordering and sorting, counting to 30 and beyond, writing and recognising number, adding and subtracting to 20, shape, position, measurement, time, data handling, symmetry and early division. The children will be motivated and encouraged through outdoor learning and class maths challenges. Our aim is to develop a love of maths to use every day with confidence and curiosity.

Other Curricular Areas

Our first topic will be People who help us. This will enable the children to develop an understanding of the different roles people play and how they can help them. We will then move on to Pets and other animals. Where the children will discover animal welfare, habitats, animal categories e.g. Pets, livestock and wild animals. In our friends and friendship topic the children will learn about kindness, sharing and how to be a good friend through, stories, roleplay and fun collaborative activities. An investigation of the weather and the different seasons. Discussing climate and recording day to day weather. Finally, they will explore aspects of sustainability. Recycling, climate change and caring for our planet. An interdisciplinary approach will be used throughout the topics, covering science, art, numeracy, literacy and health and well-being.
