Class Information

Mrs Harley will be in class Monday to Wednesday and Mrs Leggat will be in class Thursday and Friday. Mrs Leggat will also cover a small numeracy block on a Wednesday.

P.E days will be Tuesday (outdoor) and Thursday (indoor). At times the hall may not be available so P.E could also be outside on a Thursday too. Please dress appropriately.

Homework

Homework will be available on Teams and should be completed in homework jotters provided. Homework folders containing jotters and reading books should be returned to school on a Friday. These will then be handed back to children on a Monday.

Homework will be spelling and maths tasks along with reading.

Literacy

Literacy Our reading activities will focus on the North Lanarkshire Active Literacy program for reading with a focus on fiction and some non-fiction texts. The children will develop their understanding and use of the six reading strategies, in particular comprehension and knowledge about words.

In writing, the boys and girls will cover a variety of genres throughout the year. We would normally focus on one genre for a 4 week block before moving on to the next genre.

The children will be taught grammar, spelling and handwriting on a daily basis.

<u>Numeracy</u>

Throughout the year the boys and girls will be working on our programme NLC numeracy pathway and Number Talks. They will be immersed in mental agility within the four operations.

It would be helpful if children continue to consolidate and practise their number work at home. For Outer Maths We will begin to look at Data Handling and Shape. Throughout the year we will also cover measure, money and time.

Useful websites to use at home are Top Marks and Sumdog. Both are used in class regularly.

Other Curricular Areas

We will cover several topics throughout the year. Our current topic is Knights and Castles. The class novel to go with this topic is Harry Potter. This will be read throughout the year. Within Science we will look at the human body and solids, liquids and gases.

Health and Wellbeing

The children have made their own class charter and focused on the Rights from the UNRC and will continue to focus on an article and right of the month. The children will develop understanding of the importance of good friendships. We will continue with a focus on the SHANARRI indicators and begin to look at emotion works.
