Can my son/ daughter use their Q Card to pay/ get a meal/ snack?	No, they cannot do this for the moment																																																						
Can they bring a packed lunch to school?	Yes, they can and we encourage them to do this.																																																						
Can they eat their packed lunch at school?	Yes, again we encourage this.																																																						
Can they get their lunch out of school?	Yes (except S1), but some shops will have their own policies on letting pupils in- please check this in advance. Note- S1 pupils do not have permission to get lunch out of school.																																																						
Can they get breakfast from the fuel zone?	Yes, this is prepaid (see below) UNSURE OF THIS																																																						
How do I pay for meals at school?	<p>For now, this is done through BACS transfer.</p> <p>Payments must be made through your bank/ online banking in advance using unique reference numbers for each child which will be provided by the school (one for interval and one for lunch)</p> <p>To get these codes please email headteacher@rosshallacademy.glasgow.sch.uk and we will email you with the unique reference number(s) for your child.</p> <p>When making a BACS payment, you must include your child's reference number.</p> <p>You will receive 2 codes: one for interval payments and one for lunch payments.</p>
