# IPAD INFO



- Remember it is your responsibility to charge and look after your iPad and charger.
- It does not belong to you, it is on loan. The iPad belongs to Glasgow City Council, who have the power and authority to take it back at any point.
- Your iPad can and will be removed from you if it is not being looked after or used appropriately.
- We can and will trace anything in appropriate sent via airdrop, email etc and can view and lock your iPad remotely if anything unsuitable is on there.

# IPAD INFO



- Some students are still having issues downloading apps from self service. This is a known issue across Glasgow and we are still waiting on a solution. You have to find work arounds (I.e. Showbie on safari instead of the app) for now, sorry!
- A reminder that the 'Proxy' pop up requires your computer username and password. If you change your password at any point you will have to reenter this onto the iPad!
- If you 'can't get internet' turn it all the way off and then click safari. You should get the proxy pop up. If not, try it again.
- 'Apple ID verification' for S4: password is 020508. If you have this pop up in S5/6 this is a code you made up during setup. If you don't remember it, email Ms Lamont.


