Below is a list of some additional tasks which can be accessed to assist with a variety of literacy/numeracy/IT areas.

Depending on the level of need the following tasks/activities can be accessed.

Electronic programs which can be accessed on the ipad/phone/PC/tablets.

Reading Wise

This is a programme designed to help with literacy through phonics, decoding and comprehension. Many pupils will already have a log in.

If registered (has to be done by Miss Drummond (Support for Learning) the pupil will have

- a username – first name followed by letters gr (no spaces in between) and
- a password – a bird or animal name.

To check whether your young person has a log in please contact Miss Drummond on gw16drummondfiona1@glow.ea.glasgow.sch.uk stating that are checking if there is a log in for your young person.

If you do not have a log in a simple reading assessment needs to be completed. This can be arranged electronically with Miss Drummond.

Once this is done a log in can be generated and your young person can work their way through the programme independently. Progress will be monitored by Miss Drummond. Ideally pupils should aim to spend 20 minutes, 5 times per week on this activity. The accuracy % is key – the higher the % accuracy the better. This can be found by clicking in the person icon.

Pupils should contact Miss Drummond once they have completed the decoding programme. There is also a comprehension programme which can be worked through.

- You need the code which starts with the letter D which is above the barcode.
- A pin number is also needed and these are below.
 - Year – Pin Number
 - S1 – 2020
 - S2 – 2019
 - S3 – 2018
 - S4 -S6 – individual (email Miss Drummond for this)
