#### \*\* S4 - S6 December Assessments \*\*




### \*\* HOME LEARNING HUB: Senior Revision Resources \*\*








# \*\* Recycling #COP26 Congratulations \*\*

## \*\*Education Reform Consultation\*\*

A consultation has been launched on plans to replace the Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA) and reform Education Scotland (ES), All those with an interest in education, including parents, carers, young people, teachers and lecturers, are invited to give their views. The consultation seeks opinions and ideas on:

- the replacement of the SQA
- the possible creation of a single specialist agency for curriculum and assessment
- plans to substantially reform ES, including removing inspections from its functions

# \*\*Scottish Government Guidance: Face Coverings\*\*

All young people are encouraged to do a **Lateral Flow Test twice a week**. Your child may collect tests from the school office at any time.
