** Senior Phase Transition: S3 Options **

Our S3 Options Process and the important transition to S4 and the Senior Phase is beginning soon. Parents / carers of S3 young people are invited to attend an online Information Evening on Wednesday 8th December at 6pm. This meeting will take place on Teams, and links will be sent in advance to S3 pupils' Glow mail. At the meeting we will share the updated process for this session, which includes an opportunity for parents / carers to attend a meeting in school with their child's Pastoral Care teacher and one of our careers service colleagues to discuss and agree their child's best possible set of options for moving into S4.

** S4 – S6 December Assessments **

Our S4 – S6 assessment diet and support sessions begin this Monday for two weeks. During this point, all pupils will be invited to undertake assessments for National 3, National 4, National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher. In addition, there is a large number of coursework support sessions scheduled for National 3 and National 4 candidates. Pupils have permission to work from home when they are not scheduled for an assessment or support session. If your son or daughter cannot work from home then please be aware that space can be provided for them to study in school. All classes will resume as normal from Monday 13th December.

** Flu Immunisation Programme **

Our **NHS team** will be administering **flu vaccinations** on Thursday and Friday **next week**. All **consent forms** should be **returned** to the **school office** by **Monday 29**th **November**.

Lateral Flow Testing

We would like to remind all families about Scottish Government advice to test twice weekly and reporting the result at https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result. Lateral flow test kits are available at the school office and can be collected at the start / end of the school day, at intervals and at lunchtimes. If your child is not yet testing on a regular basis we would encourage them to do so. Children under 16 are required to have their consent form signed by a parent or carer.

If a lateral flow test is positive, your child should book a PCR immediately and should self-isolate until the test result comes through. Please keep us informed regarding any absences related to Covid or self-isolation so that we can record your child's attendance accurately.

Face Coverings

We are still issuing a large number of face masks every day. We would be grateful if you can ensure that your child has a mask to wear and also a spare in their bag every day. This continues to be Scottish Government guidance and we will inform you of any changes.



Hand Sanitising

We are continuing to encourage all young people to sanitise hands on entry to the school each day and on entry to each classroom throughout the day. Please reinforce the importance of hand hygiene at all times.
