Foundation Apprenticeships



What is a Foundation Apprenticeship?

- Foundation Apprenticeships are a work-based learning opportunity for senior phase secondary school students. Typically lasting two years, students begin their Foundation Apprenticeship in S5, however, there are some options to complete over 1 year starting in S6.
- Young people spend time out of school at college or with a local employer, and complete the Foundation Apprenticeship alongside their other subjects like National 5s and Highers. It's a chance to get valuable work experience and gain an industry recognised qualification. It also lets you try out a career you are interested in while you're still at school.

Who is it for?

- Generally, pupils with good N5 results/ capability and perhaps even one or 2 Highers. Not appropriate for AAAAA pupils or mainly N4 pupils.
- Pupils who are reliable and mature and can manage to balance the requirements of school and a FA.

What qualifications will I gain?

On successful completion of the course, you will achieve a Joint Qualification Certificate for the Foundation Apprenticeship in your chosen subject. This is a group Award at SCQF level 6, which comprises a National Progression Award (NPA) or National Certificate (NC) and a Scottish Vocational Qualification (SVQ).

Where can it take me?

You can use your Foundation Apprenticeship to get in to a Modern Apprenticeship, Graduate Apprenticeship, or straight to work. It also counts as one of your entry qualifications in to all colleges and Universities in Scotland.

Notes on Pathways



- These pathways are designed to help pupils be as informed as possible about potential routes into a broad range of professions.
- It aims to show pupils and parents that there are multiple routes to achieve their goals and that having a focus can make school a more relevant experience.
- IMPORTANT: The Pathways are **illustrations only** each pupil will have an individual route they will take, the aim is for these to help form discussions at home and in school- **If in doubt, seek advice form the school.**
 - It is important to note <u>essential subjects</u> and ensure these are chosen at the earliest stage.
 These are marked in <u>red</u>.
 - Each subject in black <u>can be replaced by another</u> in the options form, depending on a pupil's preference.

Employment

To become a Teacher you must complete a qualifying degree.

- 1. Undergraduate: you will leave school and study teaching (either primary or secondary- subject specific). The benefit of this is you will have lots of experiences of the classroom before you eventually graduate.
- 2. Post Graduate: you leave and study a degree in a subject that interests you (eg, History & Politics). You graduate and then apply to study a one-year teaching add-on (postgraduate), either primary or subject specific secondary.

No formal qualifications are needed- just a genuine passion and communications skills.

You will achieve Social Services (Children and Young People) at SCQF Level 7, the recognised qualification for a practitioner working with children.



Widening Participation Opportunities



- Rosshall Academy is a Focus West Widening Participation school.
- This means that pupils of the school have opportunities available to help them secure access to university and college, many of which are not open to other schools, including campus visits, university inputs, college visits, one-to-one personal statement support and much more.
- This covers a wide array of subjects areas, including:
 - Engineering, Medicine, Vet Medicine, Law, Teaching, Business & Finance, The Creative Industries (Music, Drama, Dance etc)
- Being involved in any of these programmes can result in a reduction in requirements for university entry by one grade (eg an A requirement becomes a B etc)
- It also gives our pupils the edge on other applicants in terms of their experience and readiness to study at higher education level.
- Most of these programmes begin in **S4**. It is therefore very useful for pupils to have an idea about their prospective career choices so they can be linked into an appropriate programme.
- **Mr Clelland** oversees the WP programmes and can be found in Pastoral Care. He is available via the school office or at parents evenings.
- Note- Many (but not all) of these programmes require pupils to live in certain postcodes. Pupils should speak to Mr Clelland about this.







Careers Advice and Support



- Supporting the pathways of pupils is every members of staff's responsibility and we aim to make the experience of our pupils as relevant to the world of work as possible
- However, there are members of staff who are particularly linked with the process- meet the team!
 - Mr Clelland, PT Employability & Family Engagement works closely with SDS and the whole school community and has on overview of all school leavers to ensure they secure a positive destination (college, university, employment etc). He can be found in the Pastoral Care base.
 - Our Careers Adviser, Louise (Skill Development Scotland- SDS) is in school everyday to provide careers information, guidance and advice. They can found in the careers office in the Library Hub Space
 - Karen McConnell, PT Developing the Young Workforce (DYW), has responsibility for the work experience programme at the school as well as the Senior Phase College programme (those who attend college and still attend school).
 - All of the Pastoral Care team play a key role in supporting pupils in a wide variety of areas, including post-school destinations and the Options process. They can be found in the Pastoral Care base.
- All of the above supports can be contacted via the school office.
