Head Teachers Report  HT Report	S4 reports have been fixed and won't show the garde descriptors in future. Glasgow City Council report on positive destinations statistics for last year is out. Rosshall in strong position as 5 <sup>th</sup> highest in total % in positive destination. 93.1% for Rosshall. This is out of 30 secondary schools in GCC. More are going into HE and FE. Combined HE and FE, this is highest ever been. Higher overall than last year. Employment is lower but that's because more are going to FE and HE. Final figures are recorded on 2 <sup>nd</sup> April and this will be the final figure recorded. Need to share this publicly as very positive. LM noted that many HE institutions opened for clearing for home students in 24/25 which may have helped with increase to HE. However, all schools will have benefited from this.  Dance showcase is on tonight. This allows students to show their performance to parents and carers before exams. Music and drama already taken place.  DoE silver – pyjama day on Friday to raise money for the DoE silver award. Ronnie will work with the school to apply for the area partnership. Contact is Steph Cunningham. Money is for bringing in the externals, not for the training. Could apply for £6000 max. but can apply more than once as long as no more than £6000 in total. Need the quote to make application.  Leavers and graduation ceremony planned for 23 <sup>rd</sup> April. S6 event on last day is 24 <sup>th</sup> April. Details are almost finalised.
