## Where do courses take place?

Mainly at City of Glasgow College (city centre) and Glasgow Clyde College (Cardonald). Some courses also run at Anniesland and Langside.

## How does my child travel?

Pupils should use their Young Person's free bus travel card. Any other transport needs are considered individually.

## When are the classes?

Most Level 4–7 courses run Tuesday and Thursday, 1.30pm–4.00pm (Aug 2026–Apr 2027).

Pupils will miss some school lessons and are expected to keep up with classwork.

## What can my child study?

Courses include Professional Cookery, Construction, Computer Refurbishment, Business and more, at Levels 1–7, including Foundation Apprenticeships.

Each course has its own entry requirements, and availability changes year to year.

## Application Process

After college is agreed during options, pupils create an online account for their chosen college and apply through the portal.

**Colleges request a reference from school and email an offer directly to the pupil.**

**Some offers are conditional on SQA exam results.**

## Additional Support Needs

Some courses are designed specifically for young people with additional needs, including ASD. Colleges aim to match the support your child already receives in school.

Job openings are expected to be concentrated in a small number of industries, with four industries in Glasgow City Region forecast to account for 71,500 (58.3 per cent) of the requirement. These are (see Figure 10):



**Wholesale and Retail Trade:**  
22,600 people



**Administrative and Support Service:**  
19,900 people




**Human Health and Social Work:**  
17,000 people



**Accommodation and Food Service:**  
11,900 people

Headline figures for each industry do not show how the composition of the industry is changing. Within industries changes to operating practices are taking place, for example the shift to online shopping with a reduction of shopping on the high street within Wholesale and Retail Trade. These shifts are not captured in the aggregated groups. Similar experiences to a greater or lesser extent will be taking place in other industries too and we would encourage readers to bear this in mind when interpreting the data.
