# St. Angela's Nursery Class Aero Chamber Policy

### **Rationale**

To ensure that there are procedures and routines in place to prevent the spread of infection.

### **Statement**

In St. Angela's Nursery Class, we ensure that the spread of infection is kept to a minimum by strictly following the correct procedures and routines using NHS, GCC and Care Inspectorate guidelines.

## Key Establishment Procedure

- For any child who has Asthma and has an Aero Chamber, this will be cleaned weekly by a member of staff.
- This will be done by the person responsible for Area 1 or SfLW.
- Each individual Aero chamber will be cleaned using soapy lukewarm water.
- This will be soaked in water for 15mins then rinsed in clean water and left to air dry.
- This will be done every Wednesday and recorded on the Aero Chamber cleaning sheet., this will be displayed in the Kitchen.
- Within this policy there is a detailed diagram explaining the procedures for cleaning.
- Once the Aero Chamber is completely dry it can be put back in the child's individual tub.

### **Roles and Responsibilities**

<u>Team Leader</u> – To ensure that all staff, parents and users are aware of and are following the correct procedures.

<u>Child Development Officers & Support for Learning Staff</u> – To ensure that they are aware of and adhere to the Aero Chamber Cleaning Policy.
