End of School Year Mass

We warmly welcome you to attend 10am Mass with us on the final day of term. Some of our P7 children will be reading and presenting the Offertory.

P7 Last Day Arrangements

I would like to update you with regards to the last day arrangements for P7. We very much enjoyed their Graduation this week and thank you for your attendance and support. We will have our final Assembly of the year on Tuesday during which the P7 children will receive their Leaver Certificate, Confirmation and Pope Francis Faith Award Certificates too.

We have been notified by some P7 parents that a piper has been sought by them for the last day of school.

As you can appreciate, the safe exit of all classes at 1pm is paramount and therefore we have arranged the following:

- At 12.45pm every class will line up in the playground (in their fire drill position) and clap/cheer the P7 children as they lap the playground.
- At 12.50pm we will open the playground gate nearest the nursery for 2 adults per P7 child to enter. We ask that these adults stand at the huts facing down towards the car park.
- Following this, P7 will be piped out from their usual exit door, walk past the building in the direction of the dining hall, turn and walk back towards the MUGA and enter the MUGA. They are permitted at this point to place their tie on the fence. P7 should be collected from inside the MUGA. For health and safety reasons no climbing of the fence is permitted.
- At 1pm the nursery end gate and car park gate will then be opened for the safe entry of other adults who can collect P2-P6 from their class lines (in front of the MUGA).
- The MUGA and playground gates will be closed by 1.15pm.
