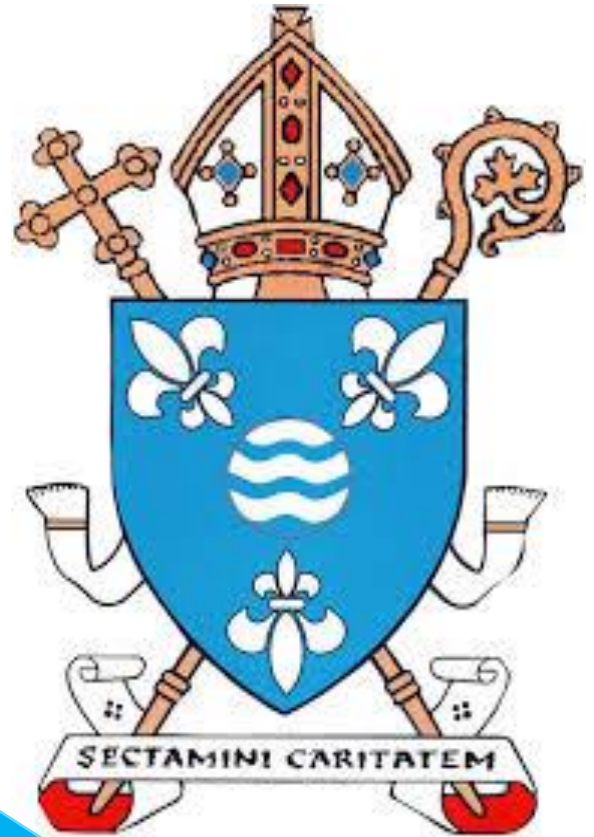


# Primary 3 Prayers

### Introductory Rite:

### Penitential Rite

Confetior: I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

**Priest: Lord, have mercy.**

People: Lord, have mercy.

**Priest: Christ, have mercy.**

People: Christ, have mercy.

**Priest: Lord, have mercy.**

People: Lord, have mercy.

### After First and Second Readings:

**Proclaimer: The Word of the Lord.**

All: Thanks be to God.

### Before the Gospel:

**Priest/Deacon: The Lord be with you.**

People: And with your spirit.

**Deacon/Priest: A reading from the holy Gospel according to...**

People: Glory to you, O Lord.

### After the Gospel:

**Priest/Deacon: The Gospel of the Lord.**

All: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

*CONCLUDING RITE Greeting and blessing*

Priest: The Lord be with you.

People: And with your spirit.

Priest: May almighty God bless you: the  
Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

People: Amen.

Priest or Deacon: Go forth, the Mass is ended. (or another version)

People: Thanks be to God.
