Begin by [selecting](#) and [researching](#) your topic, then [present](#) the information in a variety of ways.

You are encouraged to ask advice from teachers, parents or other reliable sources, to produce the highest possible standard of project work, BUT please remember that the finished project must be all your own work.

Points to remember:

- You may [handwrite](#) or [word process](#) your project, or use a mixture of both.
- Include a [variety of presentation techniques](#)
- Make it interesting and attractive for readers to enjoy.
- Make sure the front page clearly states your [title](#) and your [name](#)
- Include an [introduction](#), [conclusion](#), [glossary](#) and [bibliography](#)

Helpful hints for a Personal Project

1. Select a topic you are personally interested in
2. Spend time researching the topic thoroughly
3. Be selective about what you include
4. Reference all your sources in the bibliography
5. Vary your presentation by including things like:
 - tables
 - graphs
 - maps
 - lists
 - photographs/illustrations
 - diagrams
 - newspaper cuttings
 - artefacts
 - quizzes
 - diary entries
 - related adverts
 - games
 - any fun, interesting or clever way of presenting what you have found!
