During the above days the normal timetable will be adjusted and S1 - 3 pupils will be able to take part in one of the many activities on offer.

We see this as a very important part of our pupils' education - the opportunities for personal and social development are immense and the week is fully complimentary in scope and in opportunity to normal timetabled classes. The normal disciplinary and behaviour regulations of the school continue to apply during Activities Week. Indeed, unsatisfactory behaviour during the school session may result in the opportunity to attend Activities being withdrawn.

This brochure outlines the varied activities, approximate group size and the costs involved. **All costs are approximate**, as final figures will not be known until the group numbers are confirmed. For further information about specific activities pupils should contact the teacher named for each activity. Choices have to be made soon so that we can arrange transport, accommodation, etc.

The activities have been grouped under three headings :- In School, Awaydays, Awayweek - Europe

What do I do if I want to participate in Activities Week?

- The booklet will be issued to all S1-3 pupils Monday 24th September
- A deposit of between £50 - £200 is required for most activities. Please note that once your son/daughter has been allocated a place on an activity the deposit and all future payments made, are non-refundable. Please note that you are also required to pay the full cost of the activity should your child withdraw at a later stage.
- All payments will be online via PARENTPAY. If you do not have your activation letter or wish to pay using Paypoint then please contact the school office. **NO CASH** will be accepted.
- Pupils should return the tear off slip at the back of the booklet stating name, class, chosen activity and amount paid via Parentpay.
- All tear off slips should be returned to the school office by Friday 5th October.

Once deposits have been collected from all 3 year groups, students will receive a letter to confirm the activity they have been allocated and the payment schedule. In the event of an activity being oversubscribed a ballot will take place to determine which pupils have been successful. Those who are unsuccessful will have their deposits refunded or may be able to join an alternative activity.
