We have the right to the best possible health - Water Bottles

We have noticed a large increase in children leaving the class to fill up water bottles. We ask that the children bring their water bottles to school filled. The children will have the opportunity to fill water bottles at Breakfast Club, at break time, lunch time and at home time. This reduces the times that the children are out of class. In addition to the loss of learning time, sometimes, when queuing to fill water bottles, the children can become involved in a situation where positive relationships are not being displayed as there is no adult supervision at water stations. We wish to reduce this and ensure all children are safe.


We have the right to meet other children and join groups – After School Clubs

Breakfast Club/Clothing Grant



Our breakfast club is open 5 days a week from 8 a.m. All children are welcome to attend. Just bring them along to the canteen area.

Access is through the door at the amphitheatre.

If you are in receipt of a clothing grant then the breakfast club is free. Otherwise the cost is £1 per day.

You may qualify for a clothing grant if one of the following statements applies to your family circumstances:

- You are currently in receipt of:
- Income Support (IS);
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance (JSA);
- Any income related element of Employment and Support Allowance (ESA);
- Child Tax Credit, but not Working Tax Credit, and your income is less than £19,995 (in 2024/2025) as assessed by HMRC;
- Working Tax Credit and/or Child Tax Credit and have an income of no more than £15,051 (in 2024/2025) as assessed by HMRC;
- Universal Credit, where your take home pay does not exceed £1,199,
- you are seeking asylum and receiving support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- You look after a child/children as part of a formal Kinship Care agreement, registered by Social Work Services.
