Attendance Matters

Good attendance is vital for your child's success and wellbeing.

Here's what different attendance levels mean over the school year:

- 100% Excellent: Best chance of success.
- 95% Good: Around 9 days missed. Still a strong start.
- 90% Poor: Around 19 days missed. Harder to progress.
- 85% Very Poor: Around 27 days missed. Serious impact on learning.
- 80% Unacceptable: Around 36 days missed. Half a term lost.

Please help your child by ensuring they arrive on time each day. Our school day runs **9.00am - 3.00pm**.

Pick Up and Drop Off

UNCRC Article 3 The best interest of the child must be a priority

- Playgrounds are supervised from **8.45am**. Breakfast Club is open from **8.00am**. **Please enter** through the playground at the back of the school.
- For safety, please do not enter the playground at drop-off and pick-up times.
- Please be respectful to our elderly neighbours when parking, and use the **park and stride facility** on Blairmore Road.
- Always use the school crossing patrols on Blairmore Road and Kilmacolm Road.
- Please make sure your child knows their end-of-day arrangements.

Cost of school Day

We are mindful of costs for families. Parent Voice and St Laurence's Parish supported **transport costs** last year.

This year we will be unable to fully subsidise educational visits so we will be asking parents to contribute to this through adding funds to their <u>Parent Pay</u> account.


Over the next few weeks, we will be sharing a form where you can put your name forward if you'd like to be involved.
