Due to the current COVID -19 situation meals will be served differently in the immediate start to session 20/21. Please be assured that although the menu is reduced the quality of food remains to the same high standard. All nursery meals and P1- P4 meals are free for pupils; the cost of a meal for P5- P7 is **£2.15** and **£2.80** for adults.

A complete meal will comprise of either Main meal option 1 or 2 with vegetables/salad, fresh fruit, a dessert and a drink, all individually packaged and delivered to your child in their classroom. Special dietary requirements can be catered for on request from your child's dietician.
