Recipe Of The Month - Mrs. Barney



To celebrate Chinese New Year, our first recipe in this new column is Egg Fried Rice.

Ingredients

5ml vegetable oil

2 rashers bacon

1 small onion

1 spring onion

50g rice

25g frozen peas

25g sweetcorn

5ml soy sauce

1 egg



Method

- 1 Half fill pan with water and bring to the boil
- 2 Wash rice in sieve
- 3 Place rice in boiling water and reduce to a simmer.

- 4 Peel and chop onion and slice spring onion
- 5 Cut bacon into matchstick strips.
- 6 Beat together egg, salt and pepper.
- 7 Heat oil in a wok or frying pan.
- 8 Stir fry bacon and onion for 1-2 mins
- 9 Drain rice
- 10 Add spring onion, peas, rice and soy sauce and cook for 5 minutes
- 11 Add egg mixture and continue to stir until egg is cooked.
- 12 Enjoy responsibly.
