


A Dramatic Addition

R e c i p e o f t h e m o n t h - Mrs. Barney



Keep autumn colds and coughs at bay with this warming chicken curry. A classic for all the family!

Ingredients

100g chicken breast

1/2 onion

1/4 clove of garlic

15ml oil

2.5ml chilli, cumin, coriander

50ml chopped tomatoes

100ml chicken stock

50g long grain rice



Method

- 1 Cut up the chicken. Peel and slice onion
- 2 Crush the garlic
- 3 Heat the oil in a stewpan and cook the chicken, onion and garlic for 2-3 minutes.
- 4 Add the spices and cook for one minute.
- 5 Add the tomatoes, then the chicken stock and bring the mixture to the boil.
- 6 Simmer uncovered for 20 minutes.
- 7 Boil water in a pot. Cook rice for 15 minutes. Drain.
- 8 Adjust seasoning and consistency of sauce.
- 9 Serve curry on a bed of rice, garnished with chopped coriander.
- 10 Enjoy responsibly and wash your hands before and after eating.


