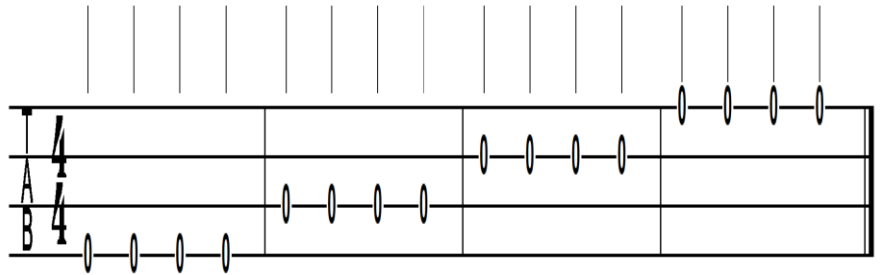
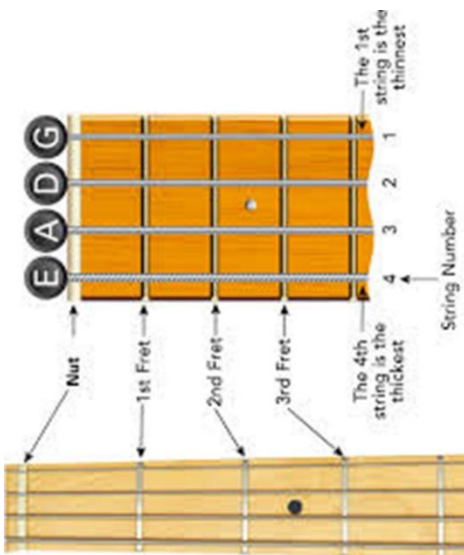


# HOW TO READ TAB


When we play the Bass Guitar, we use something called tablature, or **tab**.

Each line represents each string.

The number tells you which **fret** to play.


