Recipe of the month - Mrs. Barney



Keep your sugar levels up with this nutritious Apple Crumble. Best enjoyed as part of a balanced diet and only if you eat your vegetables first!

Ingredients

- 100g cooking apple
- 15g sugar to sweeten
- 50g plain flour
- 25 g margarine
- 20 g caster sugar



Method

- 1 remove core and skin from apple
- 2 Cut into thin slices
- 3 put in the oven proof dish and stir in about 15g sugar
- 4 sieve flour into a bowl
- 5 cut margarine into small pieces and rub into flour and sugar until mixture looks like breadcrumbs
- 6 spoon the crumble evenly over fruit
- 7 bake for 25 minutes until golden brown.
- 8 Enjoy responsibly wearing a face covering and adhering to social distancing guidelines.


