

# Drama on the High Seas





#### What is your favourite movie?



Opening just before Starbucks in Greenock, Craigy Coffee has hit the ground running as one of the newest additions to the Inverclyde coffee scene. We sent our new food review team to Craigy Coffee to give their verdict in the 5 most important categories: quality of coffee, drinks selection, pricing, service, staff and food.

#### How good is the coffee?

It is made in a proper espresso machine with real ground coffee.
