










KEYBOARD COURSE CONTENTS



This booklet will help get you started on the keyboard or tuned percussion instrument (e.g. xylophone or glockenspiel).

It introduces you to rhythm and ways to find notes, using *figurenotes* and standard musical notation.


All pieces are shown in *figurenotes* stage one, *figurenotes* stage two and standard notation.

The pieces gradually increase in their level of challenge and encourage you to play along with your left hand and a keyboard rhythm as soon as you can.




This diagram shows how figurenotes and standard notation relate to each other.



The diagram below shows the different types of notes:











The notes on the lines can be remembered with the phrase

Every Good Boy Deserves Football




Spaces






Spaces can be remembered by thinking of the word **FACE.**







Mary Had A Little Lamb












Lightly Row Play through 2 times Tempo – 80



Super Trooper Play through 2 times Tempo – 80












