

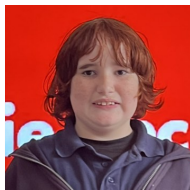

What is your favourite fast food or takeaway?

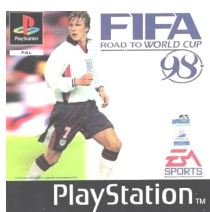
Black Pudding from Mamma Francas in Gourock.

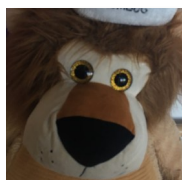
