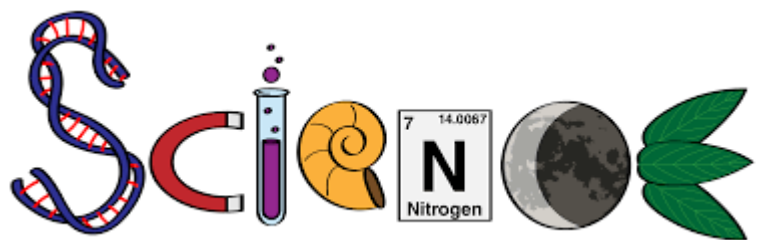
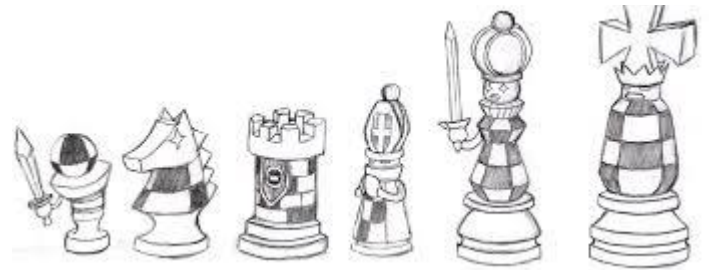

Film Club



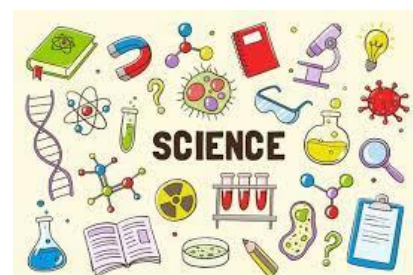
Thursday lunchtime 12.35pm and possibly after school as the course moves forward.
