The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) is an international human rights treaty that grants all children and young people (aged 17 and under) a comprehensive set of rights. The UNCRC is the most widely supported human rights agreement in the world and it sets out, in one internationally recognised document, the human rights that children (under the age of 18) should be entitled to.
