Our Team: 7 FTE Educational Psychologists (EP), 1 Therapeutic Intervention Worker, 1 Trauma Informed Practice Lead Officer, 1 Research Assistant, 1 EP in Training (EPIT), 1 Trainee Educational Psychologist (TEP), 1 Administrative Assistant and 1 Clerical Officer.

How we prioritise: Each 48 educational establishments have a link EP. Each term EPs and the establishment prioritise how best to use the service to meet the needs of CYP through Practice Level Agreements. This may mean we focus on enhancing the capacity of those that work every day with CYP. In addition, we follow our Service Improvement Plan which is based on national and local priorities.

We offer: psychological theory and research to enhance collaborative assessment and planning for CYP. We contribute to strategic development of policies, systems and practices within the authority that enhance inclusion and the health and wellbeing of CYP.
